01. The international interpretative competition is announced for piano. The applicants cannot exceed 28 years of age on the opening day of the competition.
02. The competition consists of three rounds. The third round will be held in cooperation with a professional orchestra.
03. Competition performances are public.
04. The competition repertoire:

Round I:

- a) Two concert etudes of virtuoso character, at least one of them must be from Chopin's Op. 10 or Op. 25 (except Op. 10 No. 3 and No. 6, Op. 25 No. 7)
- b) One fast movement from a sonata by Haydn, Mozart, Beethoven, Dusík or Schubert
- c) L. Janáček: two parts from the cycle "On an Overgrown Path" (based on own choice)
Max. length of performance is 30 minutes. Playing by heart is required. The order of compositions depends on each competitor.

Round II: Recital – program must include one composition from the following selection:

- L. Janáček: "Sonata 1. X. 1905"
"In the Mists"
"On an Overgrown Path" (at least 5 random parts based on the candidate's choice) and compositions from at least two other style periods.

The selection must not include the composition interpreted in the 1st round. Total length of the recital is 40 – 50 minutes. Playing by heart is required. The order of compositions depends on each competitor.

Round III: One of L. Janáček's compositions for piano and instrumental ensemble;
selection of: **Concertino**
Capriccio for piano (left hand)

or one of the following piano concertos:

- W. A. Mozart: **Concerto in D minor, KV 466**
Concerto in C major, KV 467
Concerto in A major, KV 488

L. van Beethoven: **Concerto No. 1 in C major, Op. 15**
Concerto No. 2 in B flat major, Op. 19
Concerto No. 3 in C minor, Op. 37
Concerto No. 4 in G major, Op. 58
Concerto No. 5 in E flat major, Op. 73

F. Chopin: **Concerto No. 1 in E minor, Op. 11**
Concerto No. 2 in F minor, Op. 21

R. Schumann: **Concerto in A minor**

Playing by heart required.

05. Prizes:	1 st prize	CZK 100,000
	2 nd prize	CZK 70,000
	3 rd prize	CZK 40,000

The jury can give special awards for the best interpretation of the chosen compositions. The financial awards above are subject to tax and/or other possible deductions in accordance with laws and regulations valid in the Czech Republic.

Within thirty days after the deadline participants will be informed whether their application will have been accepted.

07. Participants can notify possible changes in repertoire by **31 July 2008**.
08. **Accommodation** during the participation in the competition is provided and paid by the organizer.
09. **Transport and boarding** are arranged and paid by participants themselves.
10. In case of late arrival at the competition performance or breaking the rules or status of the competition, participants will be eliminated from the competition.
11. The jury consists of important Czech and foreign artists and experts. Their decisions are final. Results of all rounds will be made public.
12. The jury reserves the right not to award individual prizes, to divide them or to unite them.
13. The title "Laureate of Leoš Janáček International Competition", together with diplomas with their names, titles and prizes belong to all prize bearers. Bearers of honourable mention and other prizes and bonuses will also get diplomas without any claim to the title of laureate.
14. The organizer reserves the right to record competition performances. Participants do not have a right to any payment for it. Competition performances of the candidates can be recorded and broadcasted by television and radio.
15. Competition will take place from 8 – 13 September 2008 in Concert Hall, Faculty of Music of JAMU, Brno. The third round and prize-giving ceremony will take place on 13 September 2008 at 6:00 p.m. in Besední dům, Brno.
