1. The international interpretative competition is announced for **string quartet**. For string quartets the sum of its members' age must not exceed **140 years**.
2. The competition consists of two rounds.
3. Competition performances are public.
4. The competition repertoire:

1st Round (two complete string quartets)

- a) **W. A. Mozart: String quartet in C major, KV 465 "Dissonance"**
(required edition: Bärenreiter)
- b) **Leoš Janáček: 1st String quartet**
or
2nd String quartet
(edition - on own choice)

2nd Round (two complete string quartets)

- a) one string quartet chosen from the following:

Antonín Dvořák:

String quartet No. 10 – E flat major, op. 51 "Slavonic" (1879)
String quartet No. 13 – G major, op. 106 (1895)

String quartet No. 14 – A flat major, op. 105 (1895)

Johannes Brahms:

String quartet No. 1 in c minor, op. 51
String quartet No. 2 in a minor, op. 51
String quartet No. 3 in B flat major, op. 67

- b) one composition for string quartet from any period according to own choice, the length to 25 minutes. (But it must not be the same composition performed in the first round or 2/a.)

5. Prizes:

- 1st prize CZK 100,000
- 2nd prize CZK 70,000
- 3rd prize CZK 40,000

The jury can give special awards for the best interpretation of the chosen compositions.

The financial awards above are subject to tax and/or other possible deductions in accordance with laws and regulations valid in the Czech Republic.

By 31 May 2010 it's also necessary to send curriculum vitae and photo of a quartet (integral part of application) by e-mail on: polaskova@jamu.cz

Within thirty days after the deadline participants will be informed whether their application will have been accepted.

7. Participants can notify possible changes in repertoire by 30 July 2010.
8. **Accommodation** during the participation in the competition is provided and paid by the organizer.
9. **Transport and boarding** are arranged and paid by participants themselves.
10. In case of late arrival at the competition performance or breaking the rules or status of the competition, participants will be eliminated from the competition.
11. The jury consists of important Czech and foreign artists and experts. Their decisions are final. Results of all rounds will be made public.
12. The jury reserves the right not to award individual prizes, to divide them (ex æquo) or to unite them.
13. The title "Laureate of Leoš Janáček International Competition", together with diplomas with their names, titles and prizes belong to all prize bearers. Bearers of honourable mention and other prizes and bonuses will also get diplomas without any claim to the title of laureate.
14. The organizer reserves the right to record competition performances. Participants do not have a right to any payment for it. Competition performances of the candidates can be recorded and broadcasted by television and radio.
15. Competition will take place from 6 – 9 September 2010 in Concert Hall, Faculty of Music of JAMU, Brno. The closing concert and prize-giving ceremony will take place on 9 September 2010 at 7:30 p.m. in Besední dům, Brno.
